Any past due or remaining Balance is the responsibility of the head of Household.

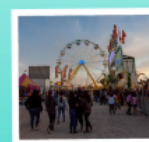

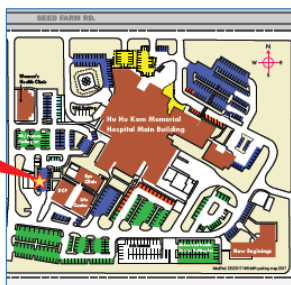

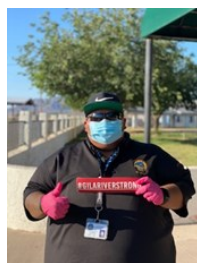
