Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training

*Gila River Health Care BHS Prevention Program promotes a suicide-safer community.
ASIST is 2 day interactive training, funded by program grants and is offered at no cost to GRIC.*

OBJECTIVE OF ASIST TRAINING:

ASIST trainings are taught through lecture, group and interactive role playing settings. Participants will learn how to:

- Recognize warning signs.
- Engage help and talk to someone thinking about suicide.
- Keep others safe and seek further assistance by utilizing appropriate community resources

IMPORTANT TRAINING INFORMATION:

- **Training begins each day at 8:30 AM and ends at 4:30 PM.**
- Trainings register a minimum of 6 people total and a maximum of 14 people total.
- All participants are asked to respect others and limit use of electronics during training.
