time vaccination for the whole family is essential because it helps provide immunity before you are exposed to potentially life-threatening illness. It is never too late to catch up if you are behind. Vaccines are tested to ensure that they are safe and effective for children to receive at the recommended ages. Keep copies of the family's immunizations records. If you need copies you can fill out a request form with proper identification at your local health care provider's office.
