CONSTITUTION & BYLAWS OF THE GILA RIVER INDIAN COMMUNITY

ARTICLE VI - Qualifications of Officers:

Section 1. No person shall be elected or hold office as Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Chief Judge or Associate Judge unless he:

- 1. Is a member of the Gila River Indian Community;
- 2. Has reached the age of twenty-five (25) years;
- 3. Has been living in the particular district he is to represent for at least sixty (60) days preceding the election;
- 4. Has been living on the reservation for at least one year immediately preceding the election; additional qualifications may be prescribed by ordinance.

Section 2. No person who, within the year preceding the election, has been convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude shall be eligible to hold office in the Community.

GILA RIVER INDIAN COMMUNITY CODE, TITLE 2

Section 2.117. Candidates for General Office

Any member of the Gila River Indian Community who possesses the qualification of office, as defined in Article VI, of the Constitution & Bylaws of GRIC (1960) or which may be prescribed by subsequent laws and ordinances, may file a declaration of candidacy for the office of Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Chief Judge or Associate Judge.

A person may not file a declaration for more than one office.

A member presently holding office may declare for the same or other office without forfeiting his present office.
