SACATON, AZ- The Gila River Indian Community will host the 58th Annual Mul-Chu-Tha Fair and Rodeo March 6-8, 2020. The theme selected to commemorate this year’s fair and rodeo is “Celebrating the Legacy of Sports & Honoring Our O’otham & Pee Posh Champions.”

Each year the Community takes great pride in hosting the annual fair and rodeo to carry on the spirit of the Mul-Chu-Tha. The event is rich in tradition, and has evolved from a fundraiser into a celebration of community, culture and sportsmanship.

The Mul-Chu-Tha offers many attractions for visitors including a parade, entertainment acts, carnival, traditional games, sports tournaments, cultural performances, Pow-wow, and All Indian Rodeos.
