2020 CHIEF AZUL SCHOLAR


Chief Antonio Azul "Mavith Kavdom" (Lion Shield) was born 1817. Azul was the last Head-Chief of the Akimel O'odtham. He always wanted what was best for his people. During battles he would unite with the Pee-Posh (Maricopa) and often led his army to victory. Under his leadership he was able to keep the tribe in its own traditional territory, rather than being relocated to Oklahoma. He died on October 1, 1909.

The Tribal Education Department is happy to announce the 2020 Chief Azul Scholar Award which recognizes educational achievements, academic excellence and leadership. This award seeks to recognize individual student scholars and provide motivation toward excellence for Gila River Students that aspire to reach high academic goals.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR AWARD

- Enrolled Members and Direct Descendants of the Gila River Indian Community (GRIC)
 - Direct Descendant: Mother or Father Enrolled with GRIC Certificate of Indian Blood Required
- Enrolled Student in 4th-12th grade or
- Full-time Undergraduate College Student
- Meets all or exceeds the Selection Criteria

NOMINATIONS AND APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

Students in grades 4th to 12th:


All nominations must be submitted on the Chief Azul Scholar Nomination Form. The Nomination form must be completed fully and must be signed off by a school official. A member from the school, K-12 Advisor Program or Parent must complete the nomination form and submit on behalf of the student. All supporting application documents indicated on the checklist must be included with the Nomination Form.

Undergraduate Students:

All nominations must be submitted on the Chief Azul Scholar Nomination Form. The Nomination form must be completed fully and must be signed off by a school official. A Professor, Student Advisor, or Parent must complete the nomination form and submit on behalf of the student. All supporting application documents indicated on checklist must included with the Nomination Form.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Excellent attendance record with no behavior referrals.
- Consistent performance at best level and demonstrates high academic engagement with a strong academic record.
- Demonstrates inspirational behavior and conduct; and continuously demonstrates a positive, friendly, and cooperative relationship with students, faculty, staff, and the community at large.
- Demonstrates desire and ability to overcome barriers and achieve their goals.
- Individual determination to succeed; self-motivated in completing challenging coursework.
- Demonstrates knowledge of and/or interest in the GRIC culture.
- Strong record and participation in extracurricular activities, volunteer/ community service.

□ One letter of recommendation from a current or former Professor/Instructor.

□ Personal Essay:"What impact has education had on your life?" typed, double-spaced, 12 point font, 750 word maximum.

JUDGING PROCESS

- Nominations will be reviewed by a panel of selected GRIC Community Members or Employees.
- The panel will rank the Nominations according to how well they meet or exceed the criteria and select the top 3 students per grade level.
