



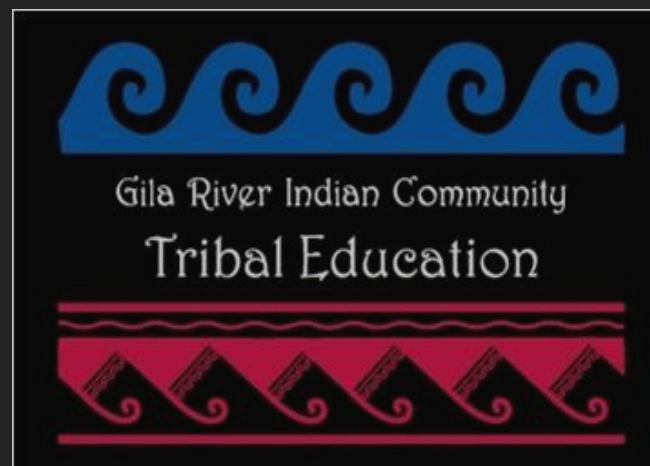

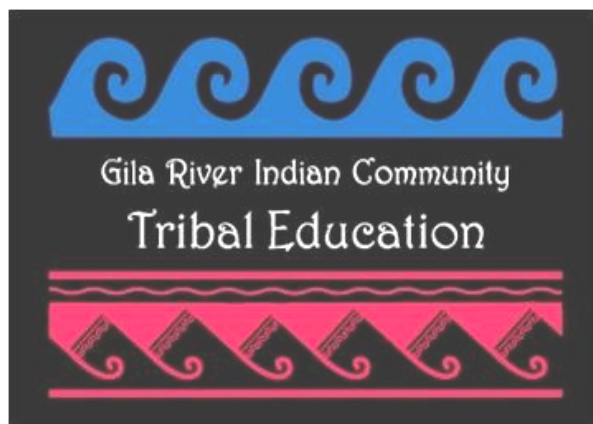

2020 CHIEF AZUL CITIZENSHIP AWARD

Chief Antonio Azul “Mavith Kavdom” (Lion Shield) was born 1817. Azul was the last Head-Chief of the Akimel O’odtham. He always wanted what was best for his people. During battles he would unite with the Pee-Posh (Maricopa) and often led his army to victory. Under his leadership he was able to keep the tribe in its own traditional territory, rather than being relocated to Oklahoma. He died on October 1, 1909.

The award recognizes outstanding students who consistently demonstrate positive attitude, friendly demeanor, and who are a role model to others.

15 High School Seniors will be selected for this award contingent upon the review of the Citizenship Award nomination and supporting documents.

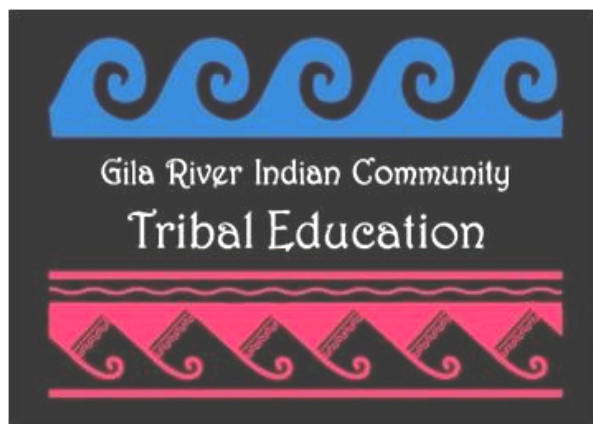
Winners of the award will receive a trip to Washington D.C.

NOMINATIONS AND APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

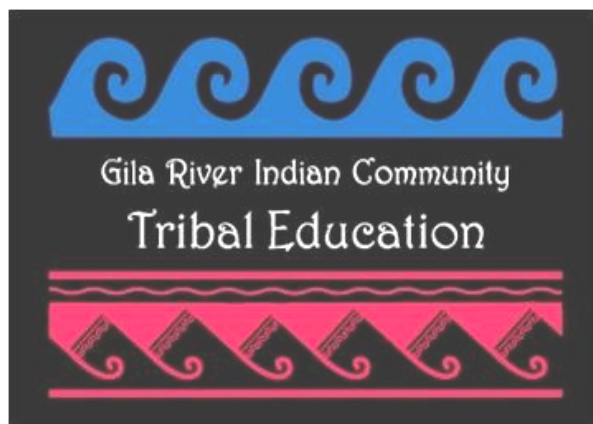
All nominations must be submitted on the Citizenship Award Nomination Form. The Nomination form must be completed fully and must be signed off by a school official. A member from the school, K-12 Advisor Program or Parent must complete the nomination form and submit on behalf of the student. All supporting application documents indicated on the checklist must be included with the Nomination Form.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Excellent attendance record for School Year 2019-2020 (95%-100%).
- Consistent performance at best level and demonstrates high academic engagement.
- Demonstrates inspirational behavior and conduct; and continuously demonstrates a positive, friendly, and cooperative relationship with students, faculty, staff, and the community at large.
- Demonstrates desire and ability to overcome barriers and achieve their goals.
- Individual determination to succeed; self-motivated and consistently improves in academic and social endeavors.
- Demonstrates knowledge of and/or interest in the GRIC culture.
- Strong record and participation in extracurricular activities, volunteer/community service.
- No behavior referrals.

JUDGING PROCESS

- Nominations will be reviewed by a panel of selected GRIC Community Members or Employees.
- The panel will rank the Nominations according to how well they meet or exceed the criteria.
- 15 High School Seniors will be selected for the award and trip to Washington, D.C.

SUPPORTING APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

Attendance Record for School Year 2019-2020

2 Letters of Recommendation from School Staff (Teacher, Advisor, Counselor, etc.)

Letters must be on school letterhead and address the following criteria for the Student Nominee:

-Demonstrates inspirational behavior and conduct; and continuously demonstrates a positive, friendly, and cooperative relationship with students, faculty, staff, and the community at large.

-Demonstrates desire and ability to overcome barriers and achieve their goals.

-Individual determination to succeed; self-motivated and consistently improves in academic and social endeavors.

Student Personal Statement (750 word maximum, typed, double-spaced, 12 point font)

Personal Statement must include the following:

-Personal goal statement with the explanation of goals.

-A portion of the statement must include a demonstration of the knowledge of/or interest in the GRIC culture and how it relates to their achievement of personal set goals.

-How a trip to Washington D.C. will help or influence them as they move forward in their endeavors after high school.

Documentation of extracurricular activities, community service, awards or certificates.

Copy of Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB).

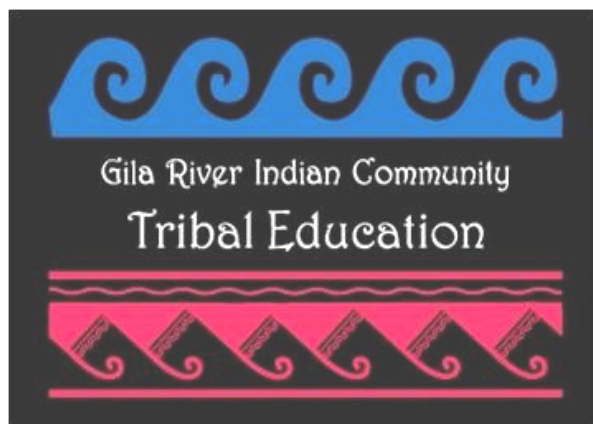
