

DECLARATION of CANDIDACY

JUNE 23 to JULY 15, 2020

CONSTITUTION & BYLAWS OF THE GILA RIVER INDIAN COMMUNITY (1960) **ARTICLE VI - QUALIFICATIONS OF OFFICERS**

Section 1. No person shall be elected or hold office as Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Chief Judge, Associate Judge or Councilmen unless he:

- 1. Is a member of the Community;*
- 2. Has reached the age of twenty-five (25) years;*
- 3. Has been living in the particular district he is to represent for at least sixty (60) days immediately preceding the election;*
- 4. Has been living on the Reservation for at least one year immediately preceding the election. Additional qualifications may be prescribed by ordinance.*

Section 2. No person who, within the year preceding the election, has been convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude shall be eligible to hold office in the Community.

Any member of the Gila River Indian Community who possesses the qualifications for office, as defined in Article VI of the Constitution and By-laws of the Gila River Indian Community (1960) or which may be prescribed by subsequent laws and ordinance, may file a declaration of candidacy for the office of:

- Governor
- Lieutenant Governor
- Chief Judge or;
- Associate Judge
