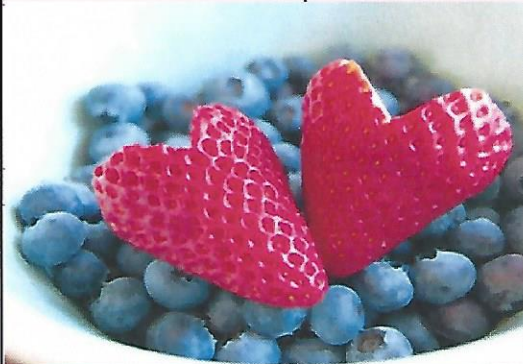

Baby it's cold outside!
Make a Pot of MyPlate Soup



Savory Bean Soup

Serves 7

2 cups Great White Northern beans; 3 cups chicken broth; 1 cup chopped onion;
 1 cup sliced carrots; 1 cup chopped celery; 1 Tbsp minced garlic; 1 Tbsp vegetable oil; 1 small bay leaf;
 ½ tsp thyme; 1/4 tsp rosemary; ¼ tsp pepper

PUT beans into a large pot or bowl; ADD water to cover by 2 inches and soak overnight. DRAIN. For a QUICK SOAK, bring the beans to a boil over high heat and COOK for 2 minutes, then REMOVE from the heat and allow to STAND for 1 hour. DRAIN. SAUTEE vegetables in oil until tender, about 4 minutes. ADD garlic, bay leaf, and herbs. ADD the beans to the pot along with the broth, bring to a BOIL. REDUCE heat and SIMMER uncovered, stirring occasionally, until the beans are tender, about 1-1/2 hour.
