The Tribal Social Services Foster Care Program actively recruits and licenses qualified applicants who are willing to open their hearts and home and provide temporary to long-term care for Gila River Indian Community's children in foster care.

Requirements to be a Foster Parent:

- Be 18 years of age or older, married or single
- Be caring, patient, understanding
- Be in good physical, mental, and emotional health
- Complete a home study and foster care certification
- Meet safe housing requirements
- Complete 30 hours of foster care training and CPR/First Aid Training
- Committed to connecting children to their family and the Community
- Pass a back ground check
- Have a reliable source of transportation
- Open to emergency, short term, or long term placement
- Able to work with a team of professionals including; caseworkers, teachers, therapists and Community members
