(Sacaton, Arizona) Gila River Indian Community Governor Stephen Roe Lewis directs all government buildings, schools and businesses to lower flags on Monday, August 27, 2018 to recognize and honor the passing of Arizona Senator John McCain. Senator McCain was a leader who strongly supported the Community, as well as for tribes and nations across Arizona and the United States.

Flags may be raised on Tuesday, September 4, 2018.
