For those GRIC Employees who work outdoors: below are a few safety tips:











- Please pay attention to weather forecasts as they inform your day to day decisions. These decisions may bring safety to you and your family.

The skies will start to clear for Monday with a high of 63 degrees for the Community and for tonight will be mostly clear with a low of 39 degrees. Afternoon highs will warm up each day through Wednesday before another storm pushes into the Community dropping temperatures slightly. There will be a 10 percent chance of slight showers for Wednesday night through Thursday. Skies will clear out Friday before another Pacific Storm brings rain and cooler weather to the Community for the weekend.

## Driving in Heavy Fog tips:

- **Never drive on high beam**-Drive on low beam or fog lights. Low beam directs light down onto the road and makes you visible to other driver on the road.
- **In case of zero visibility**-Follow painted lane markings on the road as a guide.
- **Be Patient**-Do not overtake other vehicles or pass lines of traffic.
- **Indicate well in time**- Give right/left indicators at least 10 seconds before you take any turn.
