The 3-day event is open to Gila River High School students. The agenda will expose the students to inter-active sessions & exciting speakers. This includes but is not limited to Gila River Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Chief Judge, Associate Judge, Children's Court Judge, Tribal Council Representatives, Tribal Law Office, Tribal Probation Office, Community Historians, and Language Teachers. This program enables Gila River Indian Community students to receive "hands-on" experience in Tribal Government, Culture, and History.

We are inviting GRIC high school students to participate. Students must be approved by their respective high school to participate. This intensive three-day event will be offered at no cost to the student which includes lodging, transportation, and meals.

The eligibility criteria are 1). An enrolled member of the Gila River Indian Community; 2). An enrolled student in high school, college, vocational training school. 3). Student MUST have a sincere interest in learning about the Gila River Indian Community Government and History. 4). Prefer junior or senior level grade.
