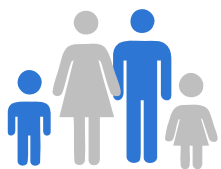
WHAT IS CONTACT TRACING?



Contact tracing is used by health departments to prevent the spread of infectious disease.

A contact tracer from the health department will contact you to obtain the names and phone numbers of close contacts.

- Case Investigation, contraction & spread
- Provide Support
- Encourage Self-Quarantine
- Connect with Services
- Monitoring Signs & Symptoms



Keep your family and Community Safe

Your name will not be revealed to those you may have exposed, even if they ask.

IDENTIFY CLOSE CONTACTS



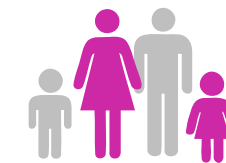
A close contact (exposure) is defined as anyone who was within 6 feet of an infected person for at least 15 minutes.



- All information is Confidential
- Encourage to Monitor Signs & Symptoms
- Encourage to Self-Quarantine 14 days
- Encourage testing if necessary
- Refer to Services

If you have been in close contact with someone who has COVID-19 (exposed), a contact tracer from the health department will contact you.
