FOURTH AMENDED EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 6 REGARDING CORONAVIRUS PANDEMIC

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, I issued an Executive Order (now referred to as Executive Order No. 1 Regarding Coronavirus Pandemic) regarding the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic and measures to be taken in the Gila River Indian Community to address the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, since March 13, 2020, I have issued various Executive Orders to address the coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on April 3, 2020, I issued Executive Order No. 6 Regarding Coronavirus Pandemic, instituting a “Stay at Home” Order for the Gila River Indian Community, to remain in effect through April 30, 2020, and which excluded certain Essential Activities; and

WHEREAS, on April 30, 2020, I issued Amended Executive Order No. 6 Regarding Coronavirus Pandemic, extending the “Stay at Home” Order through May 15, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on June 29, 2020, I issued Second Amended Executive Order No. 6 Regarding Coronavirus Pandemic, reinstating the “Stay at Home” Order through August 2, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on July 30, 2020, I issued Third Amended Executive Order No. 6 Regarding Coronavirus Pandemic, extending the “Stay at Home” Order through September 7, 2020; and

WHEREAS, after the prior “Stay at Home” Order issued in the State of Arizona expired, Arizona experienced a dramatic increase in COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations; and

WHEREAS, the Community must continue diligence in its efforts and direct measures to address the COVID-19 pandemic.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Stephen Roe Lewis, Governor of the Gila River Indian Community, through the authority granted to me in the Constitution and Bylaws of the Gila River Indian Community and Title 1 of the Gila River Indian Community Code, hereby order as follows:

First, I hereby extend the “Stay at Home” provisions of Executive Order No. 6, as amended, to remain in effect through October 4, 2020.

Second, this executive order does not affect the operations of any commercial or business enterprise on the Gila River Indian Reservation, and Community government operations shall continue to be subject to Executive Order No. 5, as amended. However, door-to-door sales or in-person solicitations are prohibited until such time as this executive order is lifted.

All other provisions of Executive Order No. 6, as amended, shall continue to remain in effect through October 4, 2020.
