Our district is located on the Gila River Indian Reservation south of Chandler, Arizona. This region was historically the center of the Pima villages and takes pride in being known as the agricultural hub for the Maricopa and Pima tribes. We also take great pride in our students and our school. We offer an excellent student-to-teacher ratio, student and staff recognition incentives, an all-day kindergarten, and a variety of special programs and services to meet the varying needs of the students we serve.

JOB GOALS: The Principal is the administrative head of the school. The Principal shall act in accordance with the policies, rules and regulations as established by the Board of Trustees in addition to the laws and administrative regulations of the Bureau of Indian Education, the Gila River Indian Community, and the Arizona Dept. of Education. The Principal has the responsibility for the direct supervision of all administrative personnel and the maintaining of an effective supervisory program for all School employees.

The qualified candidate will possess a Master's degree in Education Administration, three years' experience in administration at the elementary school level, Principal certification with the Arizona Department of Education, possess a valid Arizona driver's license and AZ DPS IVP Fingerprint Clearance Card. Candidates must have the ability to successfully complete a National criminal background check. Experience in Native American School systems is preferred. Experience with BIE schools a plus.
