Eligibility Requirements

An applicant must:

- Be at least 17 years of age (with parent/guardian approval)
- Have a high school diploma or GED (or must commit to complete during service term)
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident alien
- Pass a three-part criminal history check: national sex-offender registry, state repository check, and FBI fingerprint check

(Criminal history checks will be initiated before the start of service; and individual will be ineligible if s/he is required to register on the National Sex Offender Registry, has been convicted of murder, or fails to disclose any previous conviction. Other convictions or pending charges will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis in accordance with program policy).
