COVID-19 PFIZER VACCINE THIRD BOOSTER SHOT CDC NEW ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 28, 2021

Pfizer third booster shots are available only for individuals who previously received dose 1 and dose 2 of the COVID-19 vaccine at least six (6) months ago.



Who Can Receive Pfizer Third Booster Shot:

Individuals between the ages of 18 and 64 with a chronic health condition (such as Diabetes, heart disease, obesity)



- All individuals 65 years or older
- 18 to 64 years of age where frequent institutional or occupational exposure to COVID-19



At this time, additional eligibility requirements for the third dose of Moderna and Janssen vaccine are not currently approved by the FDA and CDC.
