

COVID-19 PFIZER AND MODERNA BOOSTER SHOTS CDC NEW ELIGIBILITY GUIDELINES

Beginning November 8, 2021

Pfizer and Moderna third booster shots are available for individuals who previously received dose 1 and dose 2 of the COVID-19 vaccine at least six (6) months ago.



WHO CAN RECEIVE PFIZER OR MODERNA THIRD BOOSTER SHOT:

- 1. Individuals between the ages of 18 and 64 with a chronic health condition (such as Diabetes, heart disease, obesity)
- 2. All individuals 65 years or older
- 3. 18 to 64 years of age where frequent institutional or occupational exposure to COVID-19
- 4. Residents of a Long-Term Care Facility or other aggregate setting



WHAT IF I RECEIVED THE JOHNSON & JOHNSON (JANSSEN) VACCINE?

1. All individuals that received the Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) Vaccine two (2) months prior are eligible to receive a booster of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine.
