

NOTICE OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

REVISIONS TO TITLE 5, CRIMINAL CODE, TO DECRIMINALIZE MARIJUANA AND TO ALLOW MEDICAL MARIJUANA ON THE GILA RIVER INDIAN RESERVATION

The Legislative Standing Committee ("LSC") will be considering proposed revisions to Title 5 of the GRIC Code to decriminalize marijuana and allow medical marijuana on the Reservation at their regular meeting on <u>March 29, 2022 at 1:00</u> <u>p.m</u>..
