



About the Program

The Commodity Senior Food Program (CSFP) is a federally funded food distribution program that is designed to improve health with nutritious USDA foods.

1 in 7 seniors in Arizona is living in poverty. We are committed to providing emergency food assistance to low-income seniors over the age of 60 through the Commodity Senior Food Program (CSFP).

Eligible older adults receive a monthly food package consisting of all 5 major food groups and a loaf of cheese from their local participating United Food Bank partner agencies.

Benefits of this program include a once per month food package for clients, nutrition education, and reduction in malnutrition affecting seniors.

Eligibility requirements:

- Be 60 years of age or older (Must show photo ID and proof of residency to apply)
- Meet the annual household income requirements
