
Tribal IDs

List 1- (one required)

Acceptable forms of ID with voter's photograph, name, and address. The address must reasonably match the precinct register:

- Enhanced Tribal enrollment card or other form of tribal identification
- Valid Arizona driver license
- Valid Arizona non-operating identification license
- Valid United States federal, state, or local government issued identification

TRIBAL ID CARD



Tribal enrollment / identification (ID) cards and Certificates of Indian Blood (CIB) are valid forms of identification a registered voter may present to receive a regular ballot at voting location. The look and information available on the ID card and CIB will vary across the tribes.

List 2 - (two required)

Acceptable forms of ID (no photo) with voter's name and address. The address must reasonably match the precinct register:

- Tribal enrollment card or other form of tribal identification
- Indian census card
- Utility bill of the elector that is dated within 90 days of the date of the election. A utility bill may be for electric, gas, water, solid waste, sewer, telephone, cellular phone, or cable television
- Bank or credit union statement that is dated within 90 days of the date of the election
- Valid Arizona Vehicle Registration
- Property tax statement of the elector's residence
- Arizona Vehicle insurance card
- Recorder's Certificate
- Valid United States federal, state, or local government issued identification, including a voter registration card issued by the County Recorder
- Any mailing to the elector marked "Official Election Material"

List 3 - (two required)

Acceptable forms of ID, one with photo, one without:

- Any valid photo identification from List 1 in which the address does not reasonably match the precinct register/e-pollbook, accompanied by a non-photo identification from List 2 in which the address does reasonably match the precinct register/e-pollbook
- U.S. Passport or passport card without address and one valid item from List 2
- U.S. military identification without address and one valid item from List 2
