

The Arizona Department of Transportation advises motorists to plan for overnight lane restrictions on Interstate 10 in the Wild Horse Pass Corridor next week (June 17-19), as work continues on the I-10 Bridges Over the Gila River Project. Construction of these new bridges is part of the I-10 Wild Horse Pass Corridor Corridor Projects.

- **9 p.m., Monday, June 17, to 5 a.m., Tuesday, June 18**, Eastbound I-10 will be narrowed to one lane (left lane closed) near the Gila River Bridges (mileposts 172-173)
- **9 p.m., Tuesday, June 18, to 5 a.m., Wednesday, June 19**, Westbound I-10 will be narrowed to one lane (left lane closed) near the Gila River Bridges (mileposts 173-172)

Drivers should allow extra travel time, drive with caution, and reduce their speed while driving through the construction work zone. The speed limit in the work zone is 55 mph.
