PARADE GENERAL INFORMATION:

Deadline for entry form and final scripts for the announcers must be submitted no later than **Friday September 6**th, **2024 by 5:00 pm** in order to be considered for judging. Timely submission of parade forms is greatly appreciated!

BEFORE THE PARADE:

- > Staging point will be located on the west side of the housing units on 79th Avenue and Baseline Road. Our parade route will run west from 79th Avenue to 83rd Avenue on Baseline and then south from Baseline Road and 83rd Avenue past the District Seven Park, approximately 1 mile to the de-staging area on the left.
- > There will be a registration table located on the corner of Baseline and 79th Ave. You must check in at the registration table no later than 8:30 a.m. Lineup will be confirmed and finalized by 8:45 a.m.

DURING THE PARADE:

- > The Judges' stand will be located in front of District 7 Multi-Purpose Building on 83rd Avenue. At this location, the script you submit will be read by the parade's announcer and the entry will be judged.
- All parade participants need to be at least 20 feet away from the parade group in front of them and behind them. This separation should be from the start line to the de-staging area (end point).
- > Only walkers will be allowed to toss candy to the ground. If candy or any item is tossed, it must be at spectator's feet or at the ground. This will help reduce any possible injuries.

AFTER THE PARADE:

- Trophies will be announced shortly after the parade at the stage. Judging is based on 4 categories: (1) Originality, (2) Theme, (3) Creativity, and (4) Craftsmanship. Parade coordinators will make final decisions regarding parade matters.
- Parade <u>walkers</u> may turn into park. Parade Elders & Veterans may be dropped off on the west side of 83rd Avenue, past new service center and will be shuttled to stage. Vehicles/floats will be directed to go around past parade lineup and park at District 7 Service Center and will then be shuttled to event site. Please abide due to limited space and parking.



- 1. Acknowledges that the Gila River Indian Community (the "Community") is a federally recognized Indian tribe and that the seven (7) Districts (the "Districts") within the Community are tribal governmental bodies of the Community;
- 2. Acknowledges that the Community and Districts are protected by the doctrine of tribal sovereign immunity, are not subject to suit by the undersigned, and that the Community and Districts have not waived their immunity from suit with respect to any claims, demands, or causes of action asserted by the undersigned;
- 3. Acknowledges that the person participating in the trip (the "trip") described below either is not employed by the Community or any of the Districts or is participating in the trip for reasons unrelated to such employment;
- 4. In consideration and acceptance of the planned trip to, from, or in <u>sport activities/events or parade routes</u>, <u>FY 2024</u> (<u>unplanned events/activities included</u>) and all places in between the trip, the undersigned hereby releases, waives, and discharges the Community and the Districts, their officers, elected officials, employees, authorized agents, and representatives from any and all responsibility, claims, demands, and causes of action, including those causes of actions arising directly or indirectly from personal injuries or property damage sustained or incurred in connection with the trip.
- 5. The foregoing release, waiver, and discharge shall be effective and enforceable: (a) notwithstanding the fact that the Community or the Districts may pay all or part of the undersigned travel expenses or reimburse the undersigned for all or part of such expenses and; (b) notwithstanding any negligent acts or omissions of the part of the Community, the Districts, their officers, elected officials, employees, or authorized agents or representatives.
- 6. The person signing below acknowledges that he/she has carefully read this Acknowledgement and Release, that he/she understands all of its terms, and that he/she signs below voluntarily on his/her own behalf or on behalf of his/her minor child or ward for whom he/she signs as lawful guardian.
