- Create defensible space around your home and clear vegetation to protect from fire.
- Build an emergency kit enough water, food, and emergency supplies for 72 hours.

2. Set: "Be Alert"











- There is significant danger in your area.
- Consider voluntarily relocating to a shelter or with family/friends outside the affected area.
- Stay aware of the latest news and information from public safety officials.

3. Go: "Evacuate"

- Danger in your area is imminent and life threatening. Take your emergency go kit and evacuate immediately to a shelter or with family/friends out the affected area.
- Follow instructions from emergency personnel.

BASIC FIRE SAFETY TIPS



Keep flammable materials away from heat sources.



Keep matches and other flammable objects out of reach of your children.



Keep an eye on the burning candles.



Store flammable liquids such as gasoline and other cleaning materials outside the house.



When using cooking gas, check for gas leaks and always ensure that the LPG tank is stored in a well-ventilated area to avoid the accumulation of gas vapors.
