Dose 1, 2 & 3 Eligibility:

GRIC and Ak-Chin Indian Community tribal enrolled members and their household members, all federally recognized tribal members, GRIC essential employees and their household members, and community enterprise employees and their household members. All individuals 5 years and older. Parent or guardian consent is required.

Additional Dose 3 Eligibility:

If you received PFIZER OR MODERNA

- You are eligible for a booster if you are:
 18 years of age or older
- When can you get it: Six (6) months after your second shot of the Pfizer or Moderna

If you received JOHNSON & JOHNSON

- You are eligible for a booster* if you are: 18 years of age or older
- When can you get it:
 Two (2) months after your first shot
 * Pfizer or Moderna only
